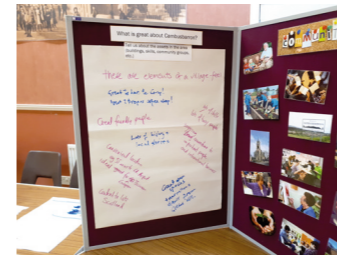
## WHAT WE DID

## PROJECT 1

### The Great Outdoors

- Upgrade and enhance playpark equipment & improve signage.
- Organise regular community clean up days to maintain litter and dog poo free spaces.
- Community acquisition of Polmaise Woods.
- Maintenance of existing rights of way and signposts.

- Install a green gym in the playpark.
- Recruit a Countryside Ranger to coordinate and develop use of greenspaces and a woodland code.

- Develop cycling and walking paths throughout the village, including adventure/heritage trails.
- Undertake consultation to consider lighting in the park.

### Activities for All

- Establish a youth club.

- Establish a youth football team.

## PROJECT 4

### Connected Cambusbarron

- Set up a partnership forum.

- Develop a range of communication methods, including a community newsletter, an integrated What's on Website and schedule of activities & events.

- Recruit an Activities Link worker to develop activities, recruit volunteers and improve communication across all sections of community.
- Information days at the Community Centre.

- Improve public transport provision
- Purchase of community minibus & recruit volunteers to support delivery.

## PROJECT 5

### Community Resources
